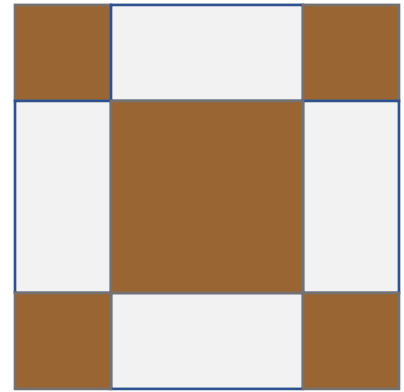
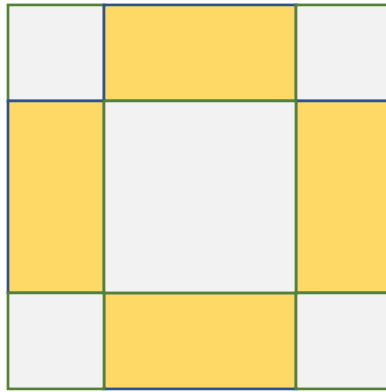
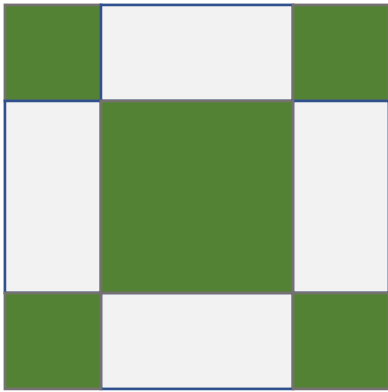
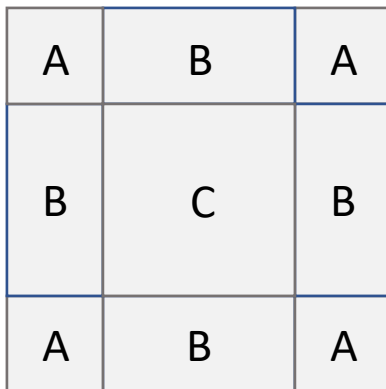


THIS WAY OR THAT!



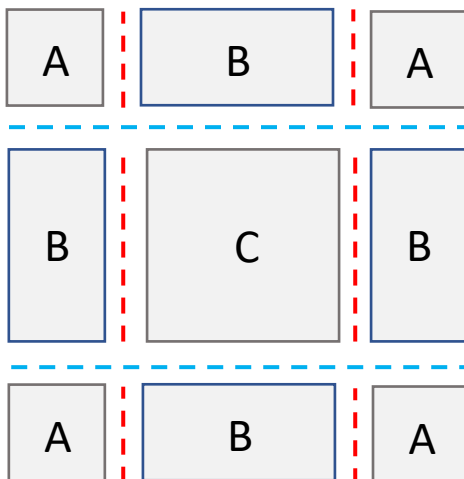
This quick little block is a great way to use up some scraps and play with positive and negative space. Because of the snafu back in August with the sunflower block we are going to keep our color palette the same using solid shades of green, patterns or textures of yellow or brown and a low volume or solid off-white background. Please only use one color in each block. It doesn't have to be the same fabric, but let's make this so we have yellow/off-white, green/off-white and brown/off-white blocks.



PIECE A 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"
cut 4

PIECE B 2-1/2" X 4-1/2"
cut 4

PIECE C 4-1/2" X 4-1/2"
cut 1



Row 1 - Sew A and B pieces together using a **scant 1/4" seam** allowance. Press toward the colored pieces. **Repeat for row 3.**

Row 2 - Sew B and C pieces together using a **scant 1/4" seam** allowance. Press toward the colored pieces again.

Assemble the Block – Sew row 1 to row 2 using a scant 1/4" and then sew row 3 to the first two rows. Press the seams to center, if piece C is a colored piece – OR – press the seams toward the B pieces if they are colored pieces.

Your block should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".
